ON PETITION TO TRANSFER


THE COURT:


The court has read and considered the petition filed by appellant B [REDACTED] on December 28, 2010, seeking transfer of her case from the Appellate Division of the Los Angeles County Superior Court to this court. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.1008(b).) This court has determined that transfer under rule 8.1002 of the California Rules of Court is necessary to secure uniformity of decision. Accordingly, it is ordered that the case be transferred to this court for hearing and decision.

It is further ordered that the matter be placed on this court's calendar, in its courtroom at 300 South Spring Street, Los Angeles, California for oral argument on April 8, 2011, at 10:00 a.m. Appellant's opening brief shall be served and filed within 20 days after the record on transfer is received by this court. The responding brief shall be served and filed within 20 days after the opening brief is filed, and appellant may file a reply brief within 10 days thereafter.

The clerk of this court is directed to (1) comply with the provisions of rule 8.1008(f), California Rules of Court, (2) direct the superior court clerk to transmit its record to this court (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.1010(b)(1)(D)), and (3) promptly notify the parties when the record on transfer is filed. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.1010(b)(2).)
