Nancy,

As the Police Department and Attorneys office work through the termination of our existing agreement with RedFlex I would like to forward discussions of RedFlex offer you generously forwarded to myself of; leaving the cameras in place for 30 to 45 day (at no additional cost to the city) for monitoring purposes. I would like to see the after data by approach as it compares to the before data. The only hesitation I might have is that we would have to compare data with the assumption that the ratio of camera recordings to validated citations would not likely change. We will not have observations validating the individual video violations.

In addition, it has been suggested that Oceanside only cite drivers in excess of 14 MPH for Right Turn on Red violations, I would like to confirm this, if possible. Does the RedFlex equipment provide approach speed or would this have to be an observed situation on the individual videos?
