Automated Traffic Enforcement System - Amendment

### RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution to approve Amendment No. 5 to the agreement with Redflex Traffic Systems Inc., to extend the term of the agreement for one additional 2-year term; and authorize the City Manager to execute the amendment.

### BACKGROUND

The City of San Mateo has contracted for automated traffic enforcement services with Redflex since May of 2004. The agreement has been amended several times, and the current contract will expire on June 14, 2018. The agreement provides an option to extend the term for an additional two-year period and staff recommends exercising this option.

The city pays a fixed monthly fee of \$3,985 per intersection approach. There are currently 5 intersection approaches in San Mateo outfitted with automated enforcement cameras. Several requests have been made to add additional intersections during the neighborhood TAP (Traffic Action Plan) process. Staff will be evaluating those intersections to analyze violation data and may subsequently return to the City Council to recommend additional intersection(s) based on TAP requests.

The automated traffic enforcement program is a valuable component of our comprehensive approach to reduce injury collisions and enhance pedestrian and traffic safety throughout San Mateo, and staff recommends exercising the option to extend the contract for one additional 2-year term, through June 2020.

### BUDGET IMPACT

Funding for this agreement has been planned for in the development of the FY18/19 budget.

### ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

In accordance with Public Resources Code Section 21065, this action is not a project subject to CEQA because it will not cause a physical change in the environment.
