The following are the statistics of red light violations from the Automated Red Light Camera system that is located at the intersection of Third Street at Irwin Street. The statistics are from all red light violations from November 1, 2009 through April 30, 2011.

There are two approaches where the camera system is set up at the Third Street and Irwin Street intersections. The first approach is N/B Irwin Street. There are four lanes of traffic where Irwin Street intersects with Third Street. During this time frame the violations are as follows:

Lane #1 – Left turn only lane: 2842 violations Lane #2 – Left turn/straight lane: 2530 violations Lane #3 – Straight only lane: 508 violations Lane #4 – Straight only lane: 134 violations

There is no way to determine how many violations in lane #2 are left turn and how many are straight through so I broke it down to 50% turn and 50% straight.

A Total of 4107 of the 6014 violations were left turn. This breaks down to 68% of the violations for N/B Irwin Street violations are left turn violations.

The second approach is W/B Third Street at Irwin Street. There are four lanes of traffic where Third Street intersects with Irwin Street. During this time frame the violations are as follows:

Lane #1 – Straight only lane: 321 violations Lane #2 – Straight only lane: 853 violations Lane #3 – Straight only lane: 643 violations Lane #4 – Right turn only lane: 2252 violations

A total of 2252 of the 4069 violations were right turn. This breaks down to 55% of the violations for W/B Third Street violations are right turn.

The fine in traffic court is the same amount for turning violations as it is for driving straight through against the red traffic signal.
