 - b. The remaining dates and terms of Section Four (4) of the agreement remain in place.



In accordance with Section 34 of the Contract to provide an automated red light enforcement system ("Contract") between the City of Cathedral City, CA ("City") and American Traffic Solutions ("Contractor") which Contract was executed by the City and the Contractor on August 25, 2005, this Addendum ("Addendum 1") is approved and effective as of the same date the City executes this agreement.

Addendum 1 is entered into with reference to the following facts:

A. The City and Contractor (collectively, the "Parties") entered into an agreement dated August, 2005 for Contractor to provide it's Axsis System to monitor red light violations or other traffic movements and to issue citations for traffic violations.

In consideration of the City's request to extend the contract term, add two additional Dual Stationary Camera Systems, and Contractor's request to add an annual Consumer Price Index adjustment, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Contractor Responsibilities and City Obligations:
 - a. It is agreed by the City and the Contractor to extend the term of the contract an additional three (3) years plus two (2) one year options commencing on the first month following the commencement of citation issuance on the latest installed Dual Camera System.
 - b. It is agreed by the City and the Contractor to retain the Dual Stationary Camera System at the intersection of NB Date Palm Drive @ Ramon Road.
 - c. It is agreed by the City and the Contractor that ATS shall install the Dual Stationary Camera System at two (2) additional intersection approaches. The City approves that ATS install the Dual Stationary Camera Systems at the following intersection approaches using wireless vehicle detectors:
 - i. WB Ramon Road @ Landau Blvd
 - ii. EB Vista Chino @ Date Palm Drive
 - d. On each anniversary date of the Term, unit prices will increase by the CPI, according to the average change during the prior 12 months in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for U.S. City average as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor.
