RE: Suspension of July 2004 Agreement – Extension


Dear Lieutenant Gundlach:

This letter is to confirm the Parties' agreement to extend the Suspension Period for the July 2004 Agreement between the City of Modesto and Redflex Traffic Systems Inc. for Automated Red Light Photo Enforcement Cameras ("Original Agreement"), and its July 7, 2009 Amendment ("Amendment") (collectively referred to as the "Agreement"), which Suspension Period became effective pursuant to the May 16, 2014 countersigned letter and was extended by the October 14, 2014 countersigned letter. Specifically, the Parties agree that the Term of the Agreement shall be suspended on a month-to-month basis commencing on May 16, 2015 ("Extended Suspension Period"). The Extended Suspension Period will continue unless the Parties amend the Agreement and reinstate the Program, or the City provides ten (10) days prior written notice of its intent to terminate the Agreement.

Except as expressly modified in this letter all provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
